FEATURED ARTIST: MICHELLE MARDIS

Michelle was born in Fort Worth, Texas and raised in the area. A self taught artist, Michelle moved to Clearwater, Florida in 1992 and is currently based in Tarpon Springs. Michelle is known for her iconic original dog paintings and is featured in galleries across the country from Disney to Key West. Her latest beach and lake house series and current body of work is a retrospect in nostalgia with a modernism take. She highlights childhood summertime memories of going to the beach & lake with her family. These memories and often staying with her beautiful grandmother reminded her of glamorous



1940s Hollywood. The simple objects such as life jackets, candy, and popsicle treats bring thoughts of happy childhood memories and harken to the past. Michelle's style of painting is clean, minimalistic, and bold, leaning on the mid-century aesthetic.

Michelle's early artistic influences include cartoonist Chuck Jones, Dorothy Wood (her grandmother) and Sina Coulson (her high school art teacher.) Her current work is influenced by the works of pop/contemporary artists: Chuck Close, Roy Lichtenstein, Andy Warhol, James Rosenquist and Wayne Thiebaud to name a few.

Sara Felice is the Curator of the Leepa Rattner Museum of Art in Tarpon Springs, where she cultivates over fifteen rotating exhibitions per year, implements collegiate and community programming, and develops LRMA's permanent collection of over 7,000 works of modern and contemporary photography, prints, fine art crafts, paintings and sculpture. Outside of her practice as a curator and arts administrator, Sara has been a working professional photographer since 2006.




